

WOMEN IN ARCHITECTURE SA (WiASA)

Invitation to serve on the Women in Architecture SA (WiASA), Sub- Committee.

The South African Council for the Architectural Profession (SACAP) is established in terms of Section 2 of the Architectural Profession Act, 2000 (Act No. 44 of 2000) (“the Act”). The mandate of SACAP is to provide for registration of professionals, candidates and specified categories in the architectural profession and to provide for the regulation of the architectural profession by creating standards which registered person are expected to uphold.

Whereas Section 14 (k) of the Act enjoins Council to take any measures it considers necessary for the proper performance and exercise of its functions, duties or powers to achieve the objectives of the Act.

Whereas, one of SACAP strategic objective is transformation of the architectural profession and in pursuance of its transformation objectives SACAP seeks a program which will among other things; encourage, support, educate, develop and transform women in the profession, as well as those wanting to enter the profession.

Now therefore, Council seeks to establish WiASA Sub -Committee to deliberately drive transformative programs in architecture for women.

Application Requirements:

1. Registered persons who have relevant experience in transformation within the architectural environment.
2. Suitably qualified and experienced registered persons who have relevant experience in transformation, with reference to race and gender.
3. Applications should consist of the following **(in the order indicated below)**:
 - 3.1. A letter of application (comprising a maximum of two pages) explaining the applicant’s reason for applying for appointment to the WiASA Sub- Committee and the value he/she believes he/she could add;
 - 3.2. An abridged CV (comprising a maximum of three pages) highlighting her/his academic qualifications, professional registrations and memberships, expertise and experience as members of any other Transformation programmes in the built environment and/or other regulatory bodies. Include three contactable referees with full names, designation, organization, e-mail address, office and cellphone numbers; and

- 3.3. As part of its short-listing/appointment process, SACAP specifically reserves the right to request applicants to provide certified copies of qualifications and any other additional information or documentation considered necessary.

Persons who believe that they have appropriate skills, expertise and experience, are requested to submit their applications to **SACAP BY NO LATER THAN 16h00 ON THURSDAY, 30 NOVEMBER 2018.**
