The Quantity Surveying Profession Act – Complaints Fact Sheet

Introduction

The Quantity Surveying Profession Act, 2000 (“The Act”) requires that all registered persons must comply with the Code of Professional Conduct (“The Code”). The Code can be found on the Council’s website (www.sacqsp.org.za).

The Council is required to refer any complaint or allegation of improper conduct that it receives to the Investigating Committee. The Investigating Committee is then required to investigate the matter and obtain further evidence to determine whether the registered person may be charged in terms of The Act.

In light of the above, when lodging a complaint, the following form needs to be submitted to the Council for further consideration/investigation:
