Introductory remarks

- ➤ ILO estimates that 4% of the world's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is lost due to accidents and work-related diseases.
- The economic costs of poor occupational health and safety practices affects both the employer and the employee:
 - ✓ Employer medical and rehabilitation costs
 - ✓ Employee loss of income

DEL has never accepted the proposition that injury and disease "go with the job"

Introductory remarks

- June 2019 ILO Centenary Declaration adopted & declared that "safe and healthy working conditions are fundamental to decent work"
- 10 June 2022 All constituencies agreed to the decision that safety and health at work is a fundamental right
 - Technical Fundamental conventions:
 - C 155 Occupational Safety and Health Convention, 1981 (No. 155)
 - C187 Promotional Framework for Occupational Safety and Health Convention, 2006

Decent Work

Significance of decent work:

 Ensuring safety and health at work is indispensable as all preventative measures need to be in place to address hazards attached to any work in a particular environment.

Fundamental principles and rights at work

 Commitment to significant health & safety improvement beyond meeting legal requirements

Approach

Proactive and preventive:

- ✓ Improvement on ERW of 1987 and thus align with technological advances
- ✓ Alignment with all OHH regulations
- ✓ Improvements include new requirements on :
 - Thermal stress
 - Illumination
 - Indoor air quality
 - Vibration
 - Non-ionizing radiation
- ✓ Inclusion of vulnerable employees and gender specific aspects on:
 - o information, instruction and training and
 - risk assessment
- ✓ Control of exposure to physical agents
- ✓ Expanded on medical surveillance
- ✓ Keeping of records

Approach

- The Department of Employment and Labour's scope of application is prescribed in the OHS Act
 - ✓ All regulations promulgated in terms of the OHS Act apply only the sectors in sectors which fall under the OHS Act
- This draft is only a draft and not applicable yet




