

Formation of A. Legal Club.

Straus was appointed to submit a plan of organization. On motion the chairman J. H. Campbell was added to that committee.

A committee consisting of Messrs W. L. Swell W. L. Gill and G. H. Hinds was appointed to confer with the Board of Supervisors for the use of the County Court Room as a place of meeting for the present should any question of occupancy arise. The secretary was instructed to obtain a copy of the rules and regulations of the Bar Association of San Francisco. No further business requiring the attention of the meeting it adjourned to meet Thursday Aug 7th at 7 o'clock at the County Court Room.
