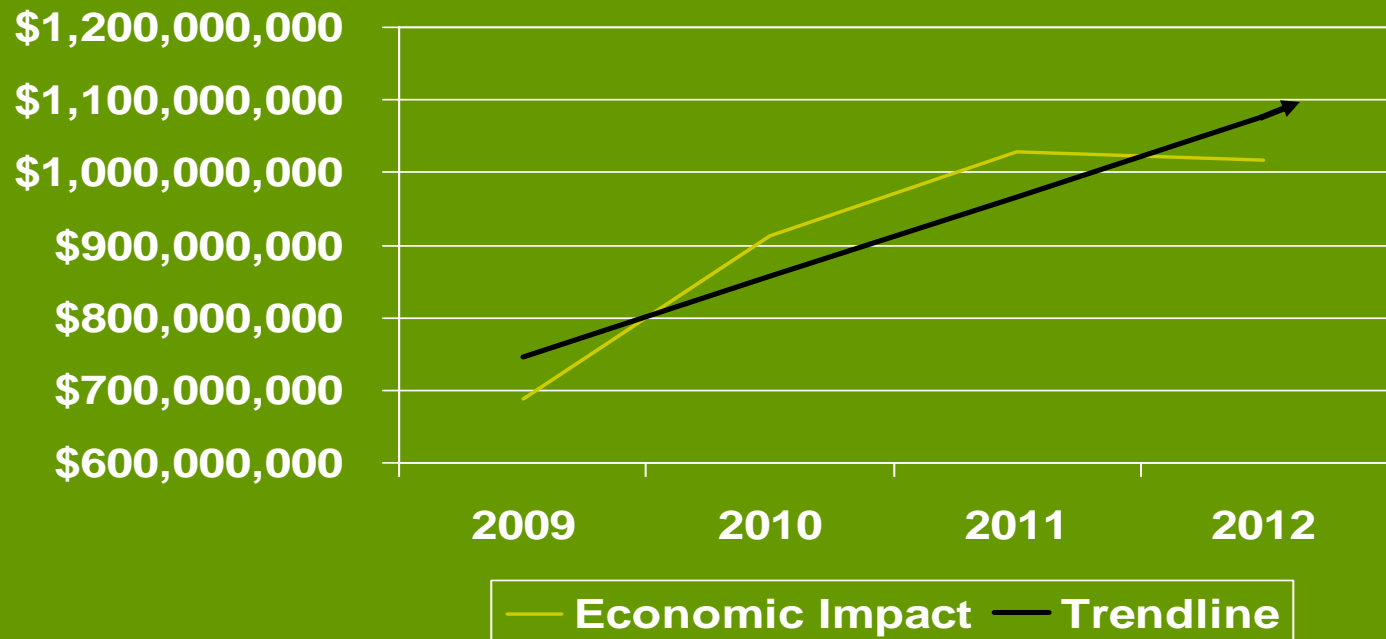

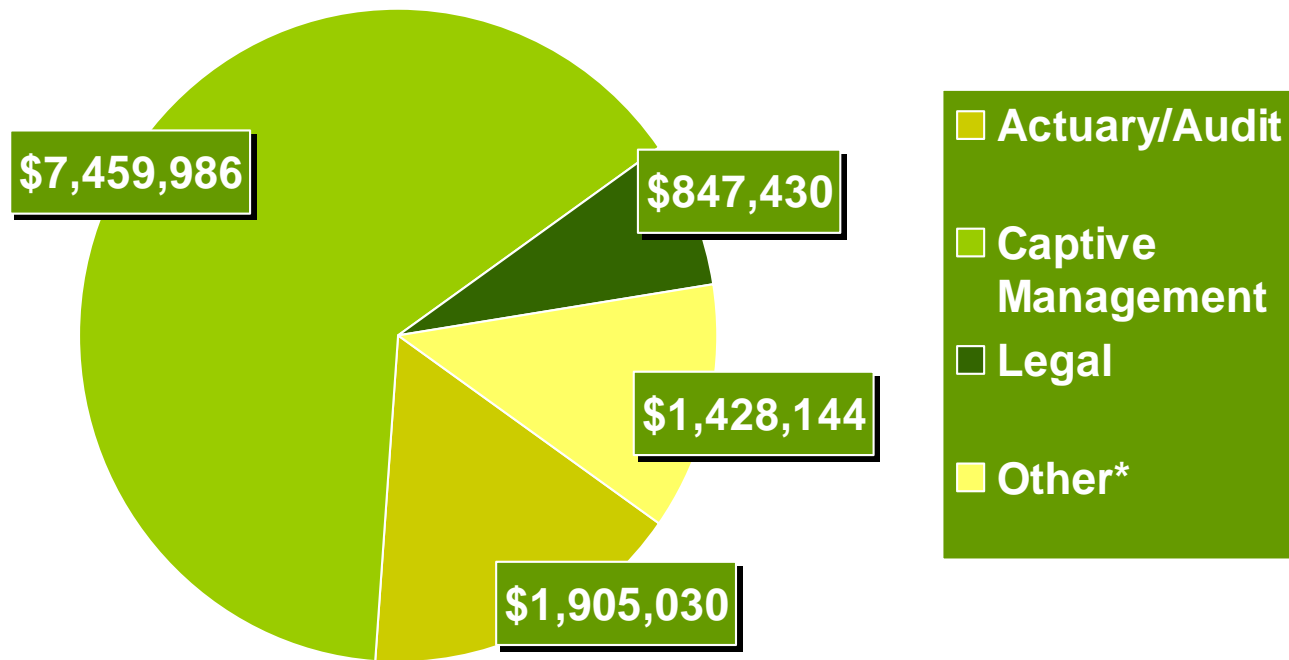

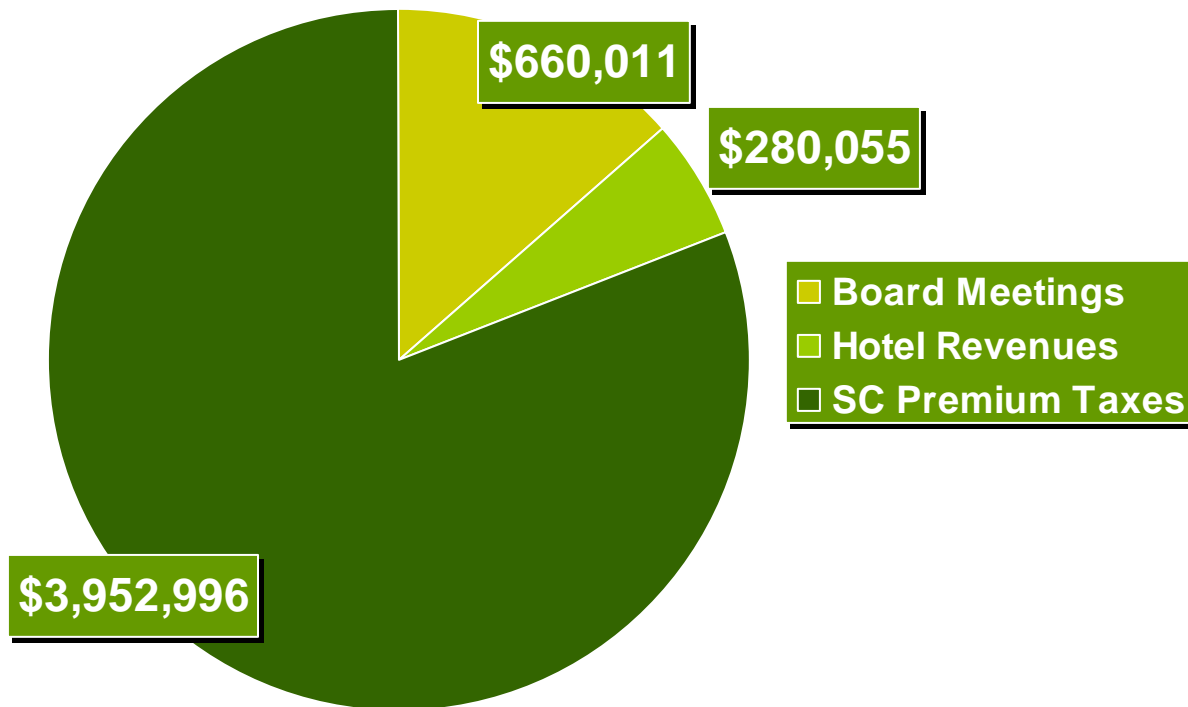
## Impact by Service Providers:
