WHO MAY SUBMIT

Social workers, practitioners, academicians, students, and all professionals. The names of all presenters-lead and co-presenters, biographical sketches, and a copy of degrees must be submitted at the same time as the proposal.

HOW TO SUBMIT

Abstract proposals **MUST** be e-mailed to scsymposium2019@gmail.com. A link to this form can be found on the Chapter's website, www.scnasw.org. Abstracts must be **received on or before November 1, 2018**. Incomplete proposals will not be considered. **All proposals must be submitted electronically**. Abstracts should be typed, and should be specific. They will be evaluated on originality of ideas and methods, importance, and clarity.

TIME SLOTS

Workshop presentations will be 1.5 hours or 3 hours with a 15-minute break.
