



Conference Safety Guidelines



SCRPA is committed to providing a safe environment for learning and networking for all of our conference attendees. To accomplish this, we are taking extra steps to change the way your usual conference experience looks. A few of those changes are listed below.

Social Distancing

Classroom capacity has been *greatly* reduced to provide adequate social distancing. Because of this, we have made the following changes:

- Opening General Session has been moved to an off-site venue, as well as the All Conference Dinner & Social.
- Education sessions must be pre-registered. Attendees will not be able to “walk-in” to a session. More information on that is available [here](#).
- Several sessions are being offered at 2 separate time blocks to accommodate all those who wish to attend. We have additional space reserved if we see a demand for more repeat sessions during the pre-registration process.
- There will be no line at registration/check-in. Attendees will collect all registration materials at their seat in the first session block on Monday.
- Attendees will be assigned an appointed time to enter the exhibit hall opening as well as the breakfast with exhibitors.

Personal Responsibilities

- Marriott hotels require guests to wear masks in lobbies and other public spaces. We encourage attendees to bring their own. If they do not have one, SCRPA will provide one.
- Do not attend the conference or any of the conference events if you are not feeling well.
- All attendees are encouraged to download the conference app to their phones. Schedules and material will be available to attendees via the app. No hardcopy program will be distributed.
- SCRPA is providing a 1.6 oz bottle of hand sanitizer to each attendee in their registration materials.

All of these precautions are being taken by SCRPA in addition to the guidelines set forth by the Marriott.
