Objectives:

The imaging professional will be able to ...

Recognize stroke from a head CT scan. Understand CT perfusion and angiogram CT images.

List the symptoms of a stroke patient. Explain the basics of stroke triage and emergent treatment to include the importance of radiology procedures. Discuss the importance of a 20-minute turnaround time for stroke patients.

Describe stroke systems of care impact on EMS routing. Discuss the endovascular management of acute ischemic stroke, cerebral aneurysms, secondary stroke and TIA prevention management.

Identify common impairments seen in patients associated with CVA. Identify functional deficits occurring with patients who have sustained a CVA. Identify correct body mechanics to facilitate safe handling of a patient who has experienced a CVA.

Discuss the role of intra-arterial therapy in acute stroke intervention. Discuss the role of imaging in current acute ischemic stroke workflow for endovascular therapy. Discuss standards of practice in acute ischemic stroke intervention.

Understand the responsibility of gathering and assessing diagnostic images. Describe the role of the sonographer in making a diagnosis or a treatment plan.
