AT THE MYRTLE BEACH CONVENTION CENTER!

The Exhibits Committee is reserving exhibit spaces NOW for the 2021 SCEC!

Reserve a spot NOW in the 2021 SCEC Exhibit Hall at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center. You may reserve as many 10' x10' spaces as you like for the 2021 SCEC *right now* for \$100 per booth. Reservation fees are **non-refundable** and will apply to the total booth fee. Final contracts will be emailed November 9, 2020. Final payments due January 31, 2021.

Your reservation fee may be charged to your credit card or paid by check. Once your reservation information has been received you will be contacted by our office with a confirmation, additional information and final contract. Your small deposit will guarantee you a spot in the 2021 SCEC Exhibit Hall.

The Exhibit Hall layout is available on the SCEC website (SCWATERS.org) for selection of your preferred booth locations. **If you had a paid booth for SCEC 2020, you may request the same booth location(s) for 2021.** The initial booth assignment will be based on the priority points system. Preference for the booths remaining after the initial assignments will be given based on priority points until **May 1, 2020**; after that reservations will be processed on a first come, first serve basis. The priority points system is included. Please be aware that the layout is subject to change; you will be notified of any and all changes as they occur.

ASSIGNMENT OF Booths: The Exhibit Booth Reservation Form and Agreement between Exhibitor and WEASC/SCAWWA (Association) is the only means by which an exhibitor may reserve space. Specific conditions of space assignment and deposits vary by conference. Each Exhibitor Contract contains exact amounts and details. **Please note, regular (green) spaces are priced at \$1,000, premium (blue) spaces are priced at \$1,400, and the large (yellow) spaces are priced at \$3,000. The exhibits committee reserves the right to increase booth prices in an amount not to exceed 5% over the prices listed above.**

The Association will assign exhibitor booths based on priority points. In the case that the Association does not conduct exhibitor booths for a specific conference the association must receive Exhibitor Space Reservation Form and Agreement between Exhibitor and Association by the space assignment date (see Exhibitor Contract for specific dates) to take advantage of priority points. Priority points are earned as follows:

- 1 point per past years (2005-2019) of exhibiting at SCEC (Max points 14)
- 1 point per each 2020 SCEC booth
- 1 point per each booth at 2019 Operator Conference, Laboratory Workshop or Industrial Workshop
- 1 point per year of membership in SCAWWA or WEASC (must be a current Member)
- 1 point for each 2019 quarter of SC Journal advertisement
- 1 point per 2019 conference or district sponsorship

Exhibitor's total priority points will be used for the next specific SCEC conference to determine Exhibitor's ranking for choosing booth location. Preferred booth location choices and booth separation of Exhibitor cannot be guaranteed by the Association. After the space assignment date the Association will assign exhibit space on a first-come, first-served space-available basis. The Association reserves the right to assign or reassign Exhibitor's booth space so that the arrangement of the exposition is in the best interest of all attendees and exhibitors.

Points will be submitted by exhibitor to the conference management exhibitors committee for verification. In the event of a tie between exhibiting companies a coin toss will determine order of selection.

Points are considered an asset of the exhibiting company. In the case of a merger or purchase, the purchasing company may use the higher points of the companies merged or acquired, thereby eliminating the lower points. Priority points cannot be combined.

Loss of priority points may occur if Exhibitor does not comply with the Agreement. If Exhibitor does not exhibit at SCEC for two consecutive years all accumulated priority points will be lost.
