**Theme:** *Inclusion: That ALL May Learn* (supporting ALL students w/ a focus on students w/ special needs, those w/ disabilities, English Language Learners, LGBTQI+ students & the culturally diverse)

**Where/When:** Face-to-face portion in Spearfish, SD on Sept. 25 (right before the SDLA conference) and then on-your-own online for a month (ends October 25). This gives you plenty of time to complete the additional course requirements.

**What:** Each year the SD State Library (a division of the Dept. of Education) hosts School Library Boot Camp, although it's not just for school librarians! Boot Camp is a free, hybrid course with a different theme each year. Two graduate or undergraduate credits come from Black Hills State University and can be applied to renewal or to the Library Science endorsement in SD. Scholarships cover tuition costs; you cover travel costs.
