

Why do we need these policies?

SLUC is grateful for its longevity and continued success. Along with this success, has come an increased number of requests for special services. Because SLUC is committed to its mission, respects the privacy of its members and has limited staff and financial resources, the Board has implemented the following policies.

Policies:

Charitable events:

It is the mission of the Sensible Land Use Coalition to promote communication and enhance education concerning land use issues. Charitable events are not in alignment with the SLUC mission statement. Requests for event sponsorship will not be considered.

Continuing Real Estate, AICP, AESLAGID Credits:

SLUC offers a variety of continuing education credits as a benefit to program attendees.

SLUC maintains that it is the responsibility of the individuals claiming the credits to:

- (a) sign the continuing education log at the end of each program as proof of attendance
- (b) obtain a course completion certificate before leaving each program
- (c) maintain his/her own records for programs attended.

Records searches for the three (3) programs immediately preceding the date of the request will be done at no charge. Searches for records prior to three months will incur a minimum charge of \$30.

Mailing lists and web links:

Requests for the mailing list, establishment of web links, or blast e-mails that may be considered, by the Board, must be from an organization that:

- (a) **is non-profit,**
- (b) **has an educational mission similar to SLUC; and**
- (c) **maintains a land use focus.**

SLUC will consider doing e-notices, or providing hard copies of mailing labels. Organizations granted use of the SLUC mailing labels will be charged for set up and production of the labels. SLUC may decline a request for either mailing lists or e-notices at any time.
