The Secretary, Treasurer, and other members of the Board of Directors, except the Executive Director, may serve a maximum of two consecutive full two-year terms.

This notice serves as the initial call for candidates. After consideration of the candidates, the Leadership Development Committee Chair shall submit to qualified voters, four months prior to the annual conference, by email or by announcement in the official publication of the Society, a list of nominations containing at least one candidate for each Society Office, if applicable, and one candidate for each Council Directorate, if applicable, to be filled.

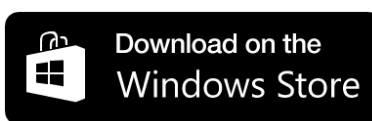
