The Science Committee is also in charge of advising the SEC about the establishment of special interest groups and providing recommendations for future meetings.

This committee has the largest representation in SETAC Europe, including SETAC Europe Council members, the interest groups chairs, regional branches presidents and members at large. This is an excellent opportunity for you to share your experience and interact with a large scientific network.
