

WILLIAM A. KLEINTOP, PH.D.

Dr. Kleintop is the Director of the Moravian MBA program, among other roles he has at the Comenius Center of Moravian College as Associate Dean of Business and Management Programs. He holds a PhD in Business Administration from Temple University, a Master of Public Administration from the Pennsylvania State University, and a bachelor's degree from Muhlenberg College.

Previous to coming to Moravian, Dr. Kleintop was a member of the graduate faculty at Seton Hall University and graduate and undergraduate faculties of Philadelphia University. His research focuses on areas of leadership, change management, and technology management; he has publications in various journals, conference programs, and books. Dr. Kleintop was the recipient of the IBM-Seton Hall Learning Space Scholar Award for pioneering work incorporating technology into the curriculum and an Outstanding Academic Service award while at Seton Hall University.

In addition to his academic career, Dr. Kleintop has served as a consultant and trainer to a variety of nonprofit organizations. His experiences include service as president of two nonprofit corporations, one in childcare and the other an historical society, and board membership on others.

Dr. Kleintop is a member of various professional organizations including the Academy of Management, the Society for Human Resource Management, and the American Society for Training and Development. He is an elected member of *Pi Alpha Alpha*, the National Honor Society for Public Affairs and Administration.
