GENERAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- Golf play will adhere to the public health restrictions specified in Illinois' Phase 4 Golf Re-opening Guidelines.
- Golf carts are permitted with dual riders. Masks are strongly recommended for dual riders if they are not from the same household.
- Hand sanitizer and masks provided in all carts. Sanitizer is also located throughout the course.
- Individual boxed lunches will be provided to all golfers.
- To maximize golfer safety, a virtual awards/dinner ceremony will be conducted within a week of the event and posted online to recognize the best teams and contest winners.

PLAYER BEHAVIORS

- Any players with any symptoms of COVID-19, should not play.
- Golfers should ensure their temperatures are under 100.4 degrees prior to arriving at the event.
- Any players from a household with someone with symptoms of COVID-19 should not play.
- Players should maintain social distance (at least 6 feet) on practice areas, tees, greens, and throughout the round. When not possible, players should wear masks.
- Players should handle their own balls.
- Players should leave the flag in place while putting.
- Players should use hand sanitizer during your round and at the end.
- Players should bring their own supply of balls, tees, ball markers, and any other equipment needed to play golf.
- No handshakes at the beginning of the round or at the 18th hole.

COURSE ARRIVAL AND WARMING UP PRIOR TO ROUND

- Players shall make every reasonable effort to arrive at the course within a scheduled time window to eliminate crowding and allow an organized alignment of their equipment on a designated cart.
- Driving ranges, practice ranges, chipping greens, and putting greens are permitted. Golfers should remain a minimum of six feet apart when using these areas

DURING AND AFTER ROUND

- Players must always practice social distancing.
 - If the group in front of you is still on the tee, please do not approach the tee area.
 - Once you have teed off, please stand on the opposite side of the tee box of other players in your group.
- All bunker rakes will be removed from the golf course.
 - Players will be able to lift, clean and place their ball within one club length of where their original ball lied that is not nearer the hole and in the same bunker.
 - Players are encouraged to smooth sand with their shoes or club when exiting the bunker.
- Players must not touch or remove the flagstick.
- The scoring area will be expanded to properly accommodate social distancing protocols.
