**Convenient Pick-Up and Secure Transport** – Trained personnel will pick up technology assets from your offices on your schedule and deliver them directly to a secure location for registration and processing.

**Asset Tracking and Reporting** – A computerized system registers and tracks all your computer and IT equipment donations so you can receive comprehensive reports verifying the status and disposition.

**Secure Handling and Data Removal** – Certified data removal is performed in a secure manner on all memory devices by trained personnel using software based on Department of Defense security protocols. Any identifying marks on your equipment are removed.

**Eliminate Environmental Liability** – Equipment which is inoperable will be disposed of in an environmentally compliant manner by approved recyclers with full capability to recycle plastics, metals and other components, keeping tons of e-waste out of landfills. Recyclers are audited to confirm compliance with applicable federal, state and local environmental laws.

**Maximize Value** – Your retired computers are refurbished by *Per Scholas* to extend their useful life for years and then distributed by our staff to students, seniors and other individuals with compelling needs for computers. Computers donated to *Per Scholas* have connected 80,000 residents to home computers and trained 3,000 low income adults to obtain high-wage jobs in the technology field.
