

## Another Record-Breaking Year for SIM's IT Trends Study!

Data collection for the 38<sup>th</sup> Anniversary SIM IT Trends Study has officially ended and we are pleased to announce that **28.64% of all SIM members participated – the highest ever!** The research team is now at work analyzing the data to provide all SIM members with a *Comprehensive Report* by year end and all participants with their *Personal Reports* around October 1<sup>st</sup>.

Without your participation there would be no IT Trends Study, so we are very thankful for all those who took the time to complete the questionnaire. Some chapters went above and beyond, with Minnesota recording a perfect 100% participation rate (another new record) and South Florida close behind at 94%. Final standings for all chapters are at the end of this message.

The Chapter Challenge Contest brings some friendly competition to the Study and this year we added the "chapter with the biggest improvement over the prior year" award. **South Florida, Minnesota, and Capital Area Chapters more than doubled their participation** from 2016.
