

## A Record-Setting Year for the IT Trends Study!

The IT Trends Team would like to extend a huge thank you to the 1,295 SIM members who participated in this year's study. That's a 32.61% response rate: the highest in IT Trends history as well as an all-time record number of participants!

Several chapters earned cash and priceless bragging rights in the Chapter Challenge Contest. South Florida and Toronto both recorded a perfect 100% participation, earning them a spot in the Chapter Challenge Hall of Fame and a tie for first place in the small chapter category. Minnesota rounded out the top three. Among large chapters, Arizona took first with an impressive 69% response, the highest ever for a large chapter. Detroit and Dallas/Fort Worth also earned cash for philanthropy.
