News Flash: How SIM's Tampa Bay Chapter Grew to Almost 100 Members in Year One

SIM Tampa Bay, one of the Society for Information Management's (SIM)'s newest Chapters, launched in the summer of 2017, and has seen strong growth over the last year. The chapter has 97 paid members and is on track to reach their goal of 100 paid members by the end of 2018.

"The biggest thing is to have an engaged board of people who are really passionate about advancing the agenda," Downs said, adding that Luis Beaumier, who served as SIM Tampa Bay's first President, served as an excellent strategic leader and thinker.
