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PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Leaving Family

During my senior year at Mizzou, I was offered a job with the Federal Reserve Bank in Kansas City. Ultimately, I turned down that job offer, but in the back of my mind, I always wondered what my life would have been like had I not.

At Lowther Johnson, I was a runner while in college, a clerk while in law school, an associate, a member, and finally the managing member. I had never worked a "grown up" job anywhere else. There, I grew up (well, I aged, not sure how much I matured), learned how to be an attorney, developed friendships and became a part of the family. It was where I started and where I expected to finish. It is a place I loved (and still do). I was fortunate to do work that I enjoyed with people I truly cared about. The opportunity to manage the firm over the last seven years just strengthened my feelings for the firm and the people. Its success was of the utmost importance to me (and is still important to me) and would keep me up at night. I always believed I would be one of those select few attorneys that worked at one firm his entire career.

Change is tough, and over the years I observed people who I thought passed on great opportunities just because they loved their job so much they couldn't quit. I never expected myself to be faced with that dilemma at this stage of the game. But I was presented a new opportunity that was too hard to pass up. Mid-Missouri Bank, a long-time client of mine, was in a position that its succession plan became a focus. Eric McClure, Mid-Missouri Bank's CEO is planning on retiring in early 2020, and Mid-Missouri Bank was looking for a new Chief Operating Officer, as Brian Riedy, the COO/President, will ascend to CEO/President upon Mr. McClure's retirement.

I had done work for Mid-Missouri Bank for roughly ten years and it seemed like a natural fit. During that time, I had gotten close with the executive officers, the heads of different departments and many other employees at Mid-Missouri Bank. I learned of its direction, culture, and values. I saw how I could fit into its future. In many ways, the culture is like what I had experienced at Lowther Johnson and that made it comfortable.

The decision to leave Lowther Johnson was likely the hardest decision I have made. It was not a quick decision and took much thought, consideration and counseling from some good friends and my wife. Within the last year, I remember telling a partner at Lowther Johnson that even though I had been approached with opportunities to leave the firm in the past, none were worth having to look my partners in their respective faces to let them know I was leaving. At that time, I could only imagine how hard doing something like that would be. That opportunity, though, was now before me. But, as Winnie the Pooh said, "How lucky I am to have something that makes saying goodbye so hard."

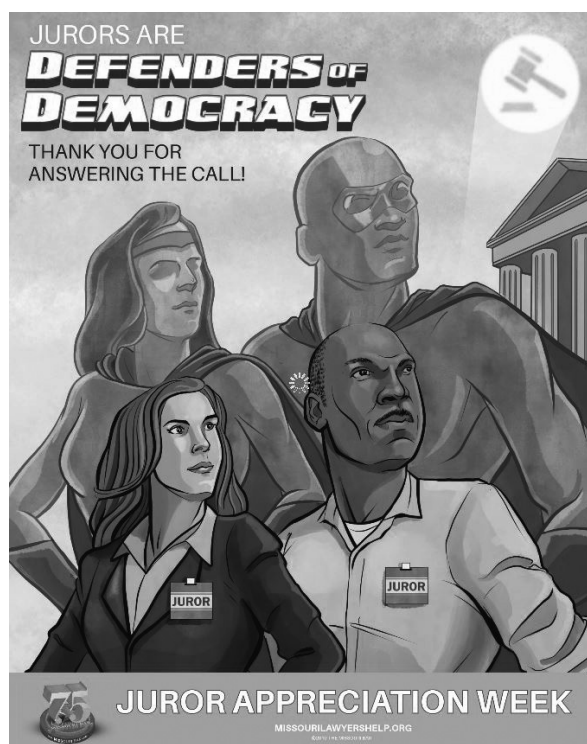

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If the decision to leave was the hardest decision I have made, telling my partners, associates, and staff that I was leaving may have been the most emotional. Many tears were shed, and sleep was lost. Lowther Johnson was gracious, accepting, supportive, and happy for me. I would have expected nothing less from those that are part of my family. I know they did not want to see me go but were happy I found an opportunity good enough that would cause me to go. I tried to remember not to cry because my experience at Lowther Johnson was over, but to smile because it happened at all.

Now, as Chief Operating Officer and General Counsel of Mid-Missouri Bank, I get to find out if it is too late for me to be what I might have been had I taken the job with the Federal Reserve Bank eighteen years ago. I will get new life experiences and add those at Mid-Missouri Bank to my family. But, as for Lowther Johnson, the saying "You never really leave the place you love. You take part of it with you and leave part of you there," cannot be more accurate.

The Springfield Metropolitan Bar Association annual Law Day lunch was held Wednesday May 1, 2019 at Hickory Hills Country Club. The theme for this year's Law Day was "Free Speech, Free Press, Free Society."

The Law Day address was delivered by Mizzou Law Dean Lyrisa Lidsky. Due to unforeseen circumstances, Dean Lidsky was unable to attend the law day lunch, but she was kind enough to record her remarks that morning. Dean Lidsky is widely regarded as one of the nation's foremost First Amendment scholars and her address perfectly captured the law day theme in the modern context of social media. Following her remarks, awards were presented in three categories: Distinguished Attorney, Equal Access to Justice, and Liberty Bell Award.

The 2019 Distinguished Attorney Award, which is the highest honor given by the association, went to SMBA Past President Jim Newberry.

The Equal Access to Justice Award, which recognizes individuals who provide significant pro bono services, was presented to Mike Bridges. Bridges was recognized for his family law and contracts work with clients of Legal Services of Southern Missouri. His extraordinary commitment was also recently noted nationally, as a 2019 recipient of LSC's Pro Bono Service Award.

The Liberty Bell Award, recognizes non-lawyers who encourage respect for our legal system. The 2019 recipient was Dr. George Connor, head of the department of political science at Missouri State University. Dr. Connor was unable to attend the lunch but Missouri State President Clif Smart accepted on his behalf.

To set the stage for the 2019 law day festivities, the poster and essay contest award recipients were recognized in a ceremony at the Library Center on March 31. Thirty young artists and authors were honored in a standing room only event, with proud family members and teachers on hand for the festivities and to mark the opening of the law day poster exhibit installed in the Library Center concourse. The exhibit was on display from March 29-May 3, during which time 42,731 people passed through the concourse and had the opportunity to enjoy the students artistic interpretation of this year's law day theme.

Springfield Metropolitan Bar Foundation Wins National Award

The Springfield Bar's 1217 Project is the 2019 recipient of the National Conference of Bar Foundations (NCBF) Partnership for Success Award. In partnership with LexisNexis, this NCBF award honors bar foundation initiatives that make a significant impact in their community on issues for which lawyers are uniquely positioned to lead. Funded by a grant from the Missouri Lawyers Trust Account Foundation and the Springfield Metropolitan Bar Foundation, the 1217 Project is a four-year initiative designed to promote individual self-sufficiency by providing legal literacy and access. The award criteria seeks programs that meet the following aspirations: significant impact on the justice system or the community at large; meaningful support from the bar members; engage community partners; and can serve as a model that could be replicated by other bar associations. As the 2019 Award Recipient, the Springfield Bar's 1217 Project will be recognized in August at the joint Annual Meeting Luncheon of the National Conference of Bar Presidents, National Association of Bar Executives, and National Conference of Bar Foundations.
