This idea is so important that our Constitution begins with “We the People,” and the phrase *E Pluribus Unum* is on our national seal and our money. When we work together, we make our country and our community stronger.

Instructions

1. Create a poster **that illustrates the theme “E Pluribus Unum: Out of Many, One”** on 8.5" x 11" thick white paper or card stock.
2. Include a separate card no larger than 2" x 3" with student's first name, grade and school. Do NOT put student's name on the front of the poster.
3. Mail or deliver entries to Law Day contest c/o Law Day, SMBA, 1615-D S. Ingram Mill Rd., Springfield, MO 65804. Must be received by the deadline.
4. Staple this information sheet to the back of the entry or make your own form with the following information.
