**Administrative Order Closing Judicial Offices at 12:00 pm on
Friday, June 18, 2021**

Chief Justice Draper has authorized the closing of all state judicial offices at 12:00 pm on Friday June 18, 2021 to allow employees time to reflect on recent events as well as the Juneteenth holiday – the anniversary of the emancipation of the last remaining enslaved African Americans in the former Confederate States of America.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 8 of the Missouri Constitution Justice Draper has advised that the Presiding Judge may exercise discretion in determining whether or not offices in their circuit will remain open to conduct any necessary business of the court.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all judicial offices located in the 31st Judicial Circuit shall be closed at 12:00 pm on Friday, June 18, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all employee timesheets for June 18, 2021 shall reflect the appropriate amount of Administrative Leave used (LWPAA) pursuant to the memorandum of Chief Justice Draper, Order of the Presiding Judge, and COR 7 C 12.2.
