### Type of Bollards

**Temporary Bollards** will be considered for properties adjacent to or across from an active construction site. Evidence of damage from construction related vehicles will be an important criteria for approval of a temporary bollard application. These bollards will be removed after construction is completed.

**Permanent Bollards** are for areas that present a --

*Safety Concern* – roadside danger, such as a deep swale or dead-end. Bollards are installed to prevent a potentially dangerous accident.

*Chronic nuisance* – roadside design, such as a sharp curve which results in repeated damage to property where bollards can dramatically reduce the occurrences.

**DISCLAIMER:** The vendor who installs the bollards on St. James Plantation is aware of sprinkler systems and how to find the heads, but sometimes the lines are difficult to locate. The vendor and St. James POA are **not** responsible should a sprinkler head or line be damaged. Also, it is recommended that the homeowner be present when the bollards are installed. The installer will be in touch with the homeowner regarding the date of the install.
