Award Winners to be recognized at the national ASP conference

Awards	Description	Nominations	Selections	Notes
Hall of Fame	to recognize lifetime achievement in ASP and the profession	any ASP member may nominate someone	all current and former ASP Board members, who are still ASP members, vote; winners must be named on at least 70% of the ballots	may have multiple honorees
Member of the Year	to recognize overall outstanding commitment to and involvement in ASP during the previous program year	any ASP member may nominate someone	all current ASP Board members and chapter presidents vote; winner must receive at least 51% of all votes	intended to honor single winners
Outstanding Service to ASP	to recognize extraordinary effort on a particular ASP project, initiative or committee	any ASP member may nominate someone	all current ASP Board members and officers, and all current chapter Board members and officers vote; winners must be named on at least 35% of the ballots	may have multiple honorees
Chapter of the Year	to recognize the chapter that contributed most significantly to the professional growth of its members during the previous program year	chapters seeking this recognition must nominate themselves, and must have been a chapter for at least six months of the program year covered by the award	all current chapter Board members and officers vote, but cannot vote for their own chapter; winner must receive at least 51% of all votes	intended to honor single winners
Distinguished Service Award	to recognize an ASP member who has demonstrated dedicated service and an untiring commitment to furthering the development of the organization and its members through donated time, influential leadership and sustained service to ASP	any ASP member may nominate someone	Any member in good standing can nominate a candidate for recognition of distinguished service to ASP. Nominees will be evaluated on the following criteria: Years as a member, Chapter Service, National Service, as well as Special Assignments. A summary of the nominee's accomplishments must accompany this nomination	intended to honor single winners
