* **Basic Benefits** – Minutes, Member web access, and educational discounts as follows:

- Agency/Industry – all employees of agency entitled to education discount
- Individual – Member only entitled to education discount
- Student – Member only entitled to education discount

Benefit Card – Entitles bearer to lunch at meeting for one member at SVABO meeting for each of regular scheduled monthly meetings. Does not apply to Installation Dinner.

Monthly Meeting Charge: - \$ 20.00 for all Individual, or Jurisdictional/Industry members without Benefit Card. \$ 10.00 for Student members. Lunch is included in the Monthly meeting charge.

CEU Certificates will be provided based on meeting attendance as well as appropriate subject matter. SVABO will track CEUs for members who attend meetings and will make certificates available for recertification.

** Industry membership is same rate table as Agency membership with one member for “up to 100,000 population”, and one additional member for each population category increase. (i.e. 3 industry members = rate for over 200,000 population range).

Meeting structure: Consider Program first, starting at 9:00 to 9:30 AM.

It was suggested that the host jurisdiction be granted one or two free lunches for employees to attend as a show of gratitude for hosting the meeting.
