- × "I would probably say Thor. I'm a muscular guy and I feel like if I were a superhero, that would be me."

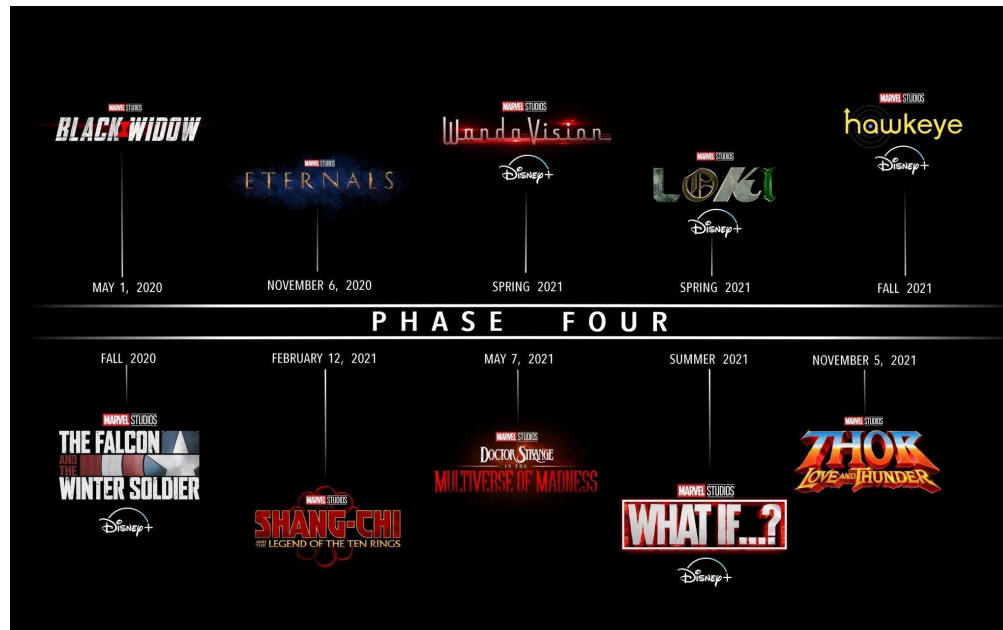
## ***SOMETHING GREATER***
