TAG Releases "What do you use?" Survey Results

97 unique foundations participated in the September 2016 "what do you use" survey. Detailed survey results were mailed to participants in September.

Members who didn't participate can [download](#) the summary results. Highlights include:

- Gifts Classic was reported as the most commonly used grants management software (19%), followed by foundationConnect (13%) and Fluxx (12%).
- 53% of respondents are using Office 365.
- More than 75% reported using cloud storage.
