Did You Know?

- **Community foundations** see staffing ratios (non-IT to IT) that are higher than those found at private and family foundations.
- **51% of IT departments** responding do NOT have DEI programs in place.
- **21% reported a security breach.** Responding organizations who did NOT report a security breach are more likely to hold security awareness training **during staff meetings.**
