Mary was six when a school started in the nearby village. Mary wanted to go to school so she could learn to read. She asked her mum and dad if she could go to school. She promised she would still do all her chores but she really, really wanted to learn to read.

Mary loved to read, but most of all she wanted to read the Bible. Sadly, there was no Bible in Mary's home because her mum and dad could not read and Bibles were very expensive. Mary decided that she was going to save her money and buy her own Bible. For six years Mary worked extra chores, sold eggs and washed clothes in the river to earn money.

When Mary was fifteen she had enough money to buy a Bible. But she had a problem—the only place she could buy a Bible was twenty-six miles away in a town called Bala. There were no cars for Mary to travel in. If she wanted a Bible she was going to have to walk to Bala!
