The Texas Floodplain Management Association is pleased to announce its *Call for Abstracts* for the 2019 Annual Spring Conference. The Conference will be held at the Hyatt Regency Hotel @ Reunion in Dallas starting on May 28 and ending on May 31, 2019. Conference presentation topics should include floodplain management, flood recovery, stream restoration, watershed protection and planning, permitting, hydrology & hydraulics, mapping, mitigation, storm water management, etc.

In addition, we are seeking abstracts regarding municipal government roles in flood response, in particular from a utility standpoint, such as re-starting treatment plants after a flood, damages caused from flooding and design requirements for new infrastructure in the floodplain.

For abstracts that have more than one author, indicate the name(s) of who will actually be present to make the presentation in Dallas.
