The mission of the Individual Services Committee is to:

- Discover, advocate, and represent the artistic needs and professional interests of individual members to Theatre Bay Area.
- Support the work of the Director of Field Services.
- Promote Theatre Bay Area services to individuals and the field at large.

Specifically, this means to...

- Solicit feedback throughout your regular interactions with the theatre community;
- Volunteer at a minimum of one Theatre Bay Area event per calendar year;
- Have knowledge of Theatre Bay Area's services and staff;
- Take part in planning events such as the General Auditions, Annual Conference and Awards Ceremony.
- To be sounding board for Theatre Bay Area programs;
- To actively recruit new ISC members.

### Meeting Responsibilities

- The ISC meets the second Monday evening 9 months a year (off one summer month TBD and December). We also try to have a planning retreat once a year (a 2-3 hour meeting to evaluate our past year and set goals for the coming year).
- There is no meeting in April (or whatever month the Annual Conference may fall), in order to allow ISC member to attend the conference.
- ISC members are expected to attend at least 5 of these meetings a year, barring emergencies, communicated absences and/or as replaced by other volunteering.
