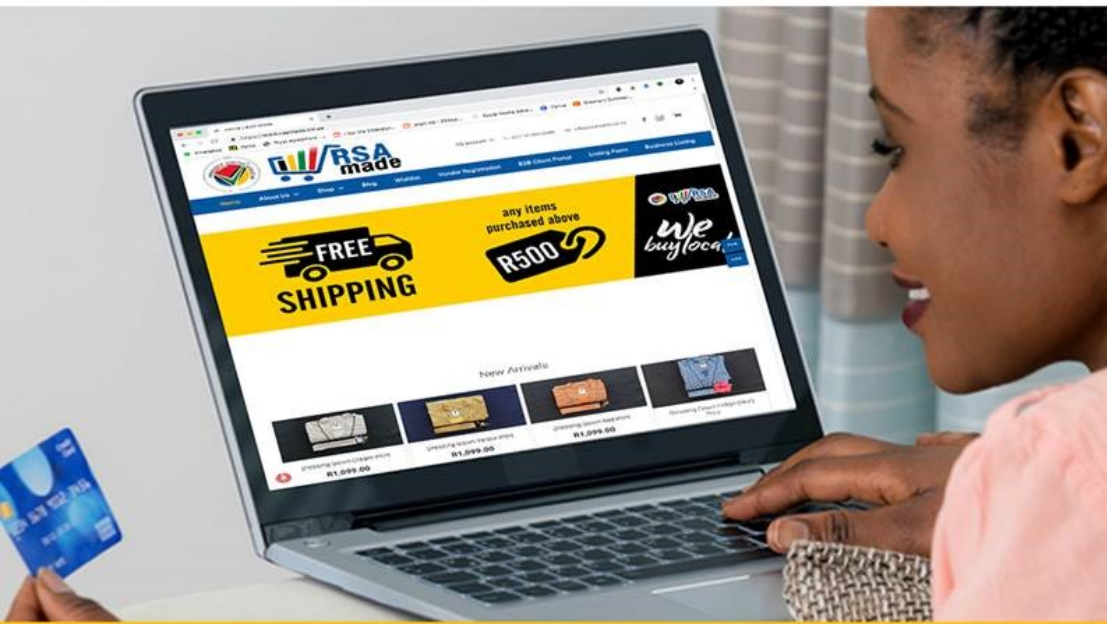


The sustainability of local production and manufacturing, and of the retention of jobs is of critical importance to our country's economy in this period of uncertainty.
