

SPECIAL COMMITTEES

The President, with the Executive Committee, shall be empowered to appoint such Special Committees as may be necessary to the functioning of the Association during a given administration. The appointment of such Committees shall be reported to the Board of Directors and to the membership of the Association.

- Special (Ad-Hoc) Committees serve only within the term of the President who appointed the Committee.
 - If the Committee work remains incomplete at the end of the appointed term, the in-coming President may reappoint the Committee for another term.
 - When the Committee charge has been completed the Committee ceases to exist, unless reappointed with a new charge.
