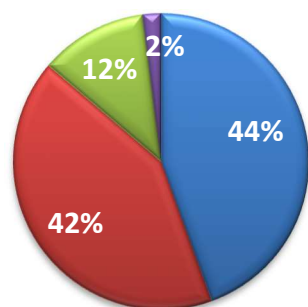


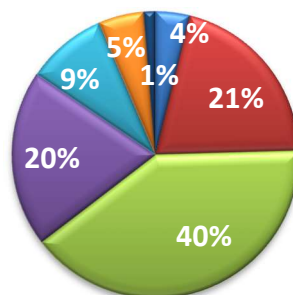
Several members are requesting data to revise best practices related to the registry team. A total of 77 centers participated in the survey.

1. What trauma level is your facility?



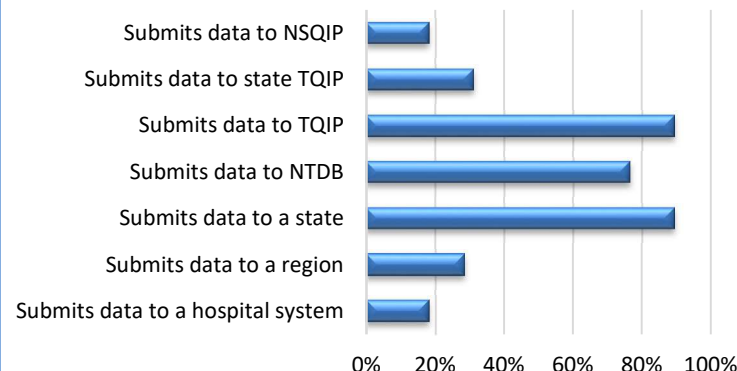
■ Level I

3. Describe your center by selecting your participation in the following. (select all that applies)



1. What trauma level is your facility? N=77. The majority (86%) of respondents represent level I and II centers.

2. What is your annual trauma registry volume? N=77. Majority (81%) of surveyed centers had volumes between 1001-3500. Data will be reported out by trauma registry volume throughout the remainder of the report.

3. Describe your center by selecting your participation in the following (select all that apply). N=77. Most of the surveyed centers submit data to TQIP (90%), NTDB (77%) and their state (90%).

4. Table: Frequency of type of profession in role of registrar (select all that apply). See table. Other responses include: **(500-1000)** both have degrees one an AD and the other a BA; **(1001-2500)** LPN; data analysts; trauma PA; MS in computer science; **(2501-3500)** HIM Coder is also a Respiratory Therapist; LPN; Registry coordinator - MPH & Registry analyst – BS; **(3501-4500)** Trauma Registry RN Supervisor; LPN; Supervisor and Information Coordinator; **(4501-6000)** RHIT and CDC.

5. Table: How many FTEs are assigned to registrars? See table.

*One center with a >6001 volume responded to questions 4 & 5 but was excluded from the tables. Their registrars are made up of RNs (12.5%) and Other - trauma registry trained personnel (87.5%). They assign 10 FTE to their registrars.
