

Engineer of the Year Award Guideline

This award is the highest honor given to an individual TSPE member. Each chapter is allowed to submit their current years winner for consideration for the award. In addition to this year's candidates, the five applicants receiving the highest scores from last year's submittals are considered. Candidates must be a TSPE member in order to be considered.

Nomination Format

Submissions must include the attached Nomination Form as the cover page, including the nominee's signature. Supporting pages shall identify to which of the five criteria categories each applies. Lastly, please provide a statement of 500 words or less, which is suitable to be used as a press release that provides an overview of the nominee's achievements and summarizes why the nominee is deserving of this award.

Deadline and Submission

Nomination packets must be submitted digitally along with a digital headshot to claire@tspe.org by March 15.

Award Presentation

The award will be presented at the TSPE Annual Conference in June.

Evaluation Criteria

A representative from each region on the Awards Committee will evaluate the nominee based on the seven criteria categories and score each with a maximum amount of points based on the following table.

- B. LICENSES**
- C. PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL SOCIETY ACTIVITIES** Indicate offices held, year held, committee assignments, and awards received
- D. ENGINEERING AND CAREER ACHIEVEMENTS.**
 - 1. Please list current and previous employers as well as a description of responsibilities.
 - 2. Significant Engineering Achievements. List significant engineering achievements, giving description of the achievement, the significance, your responsibility, and the time period.
 - 3. Publications, Papers, and Patents. List publications, papers, and patents giving the title, authors, publications, and/or audience, and time period.
- E. CIVIC, HUMANITARIAN, AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES** Indicate offices held, year held, committee assignments, and awards received.
