RE: Notification of Jurisprudence Exam Changes

Greetings,

Starting September 1, 2019, the Texas Medical Board will be rolling out the Texas Medical Jurisprudence (JP) exam for all RCP, MRT, LMRT, and NCT Registry applicants.

All applicants who apply after August 31, 2019, will be required to pass this exam. Applicants must pass with a score of 75 or better and will have unlimited attempts to do so. Only applicants with active, pending applications will be able to schedule an appointment for the exam. The JP exam is administered through a third party vendor and missed online appointments will result in forfeiture of the fee.

The fee for the exam is \$34 per attempt. Applicants can choose to purchase a study guide which will also be available for purchase through the *My TMB* portal.

The JP exam will be available online through your *My TMB* account - <https://sso.tmb.state.tx.us/Login.aspx>

Applicants who apply after August 31, 2019 will be sent specific instructions on how to schedule an appointment for the new online exam once it is available. Updates will also be provided through our website - <http://www.tmb.state.tx.us/>.
