Dr. Glenn Harnett is currently Principal at No-Resistance Consulting Group which provides consulting services to leading Urgent Care Organizations, Pharmaceutical and Laboratory Industries, Investment Groups, and Antibiotic Stewardship Programs. He received a B.A. in Psychology from the University of New Hampshire in 1990 and completed his medical degree at the Medical College of Georgia in 2001. He did his Emergency Medicine Residency at Emory University in Atlanta where he served as Chief Resident and was also named the Most Outstanding Resident in 2004. He is Board Certified in Emergency Medicine.

Dr. Harnett has practiced emergency and urgent care medicine for the past 15 years.
