Mission Statement

 - Facilitate opportunities for VAHPERD TOYs to provide professional development to Virginia health and physical education teachers.
 - Promote leadership and advocacy for the members of VAHPERD.
 - Create a "Mentor Program for Young Professionals "at the Elementary and Secondary Level.
 - To include a document with a set of criteria/guidelines for mentors and mentees.
 - To incorporate through OHPEP
 - O Continue with the DMV Grant
 - Technology Outreach engaging students and providing resources to teachers.
 - The website should have a good stock of teacher resources related to underage drinking
 - Continue to encourage and support student leadership and involvement in the association.

2. Improve the services to and involvement of the <u>membership</u> in VAHPERD. Actions that will meet the intent of this goal include:

- Improve communication for all membership, including VAHPERD leadership and association partners.
- Recruit new members and increase the retention of current members.
- Provide members with training opportunities, materials and resources to promote their profession.
- Improve communication for all membership, leadership and supportive partnerships.
- Provide advocacy information and leadership skills that support professional growth.
- Improve partnerships with other effective advocacy groups
- Increase diversity initiatives among the membership and professional affiliations
 - o Board of Director's approval of the Diversity Committee Operating Code/committee appointments.
 - Encourage Volunteer opportunities by creating a "VAHPERD 2018 Board of Directors and Committee Interest Form" (Paper and Google Form)
 - o Continue with VAHPERD Website Over hall
 - To ensure that Section Chairs, Division Leaders, Board of Directors and Committee Members are educated about and supported in their role's though a session devoted to familiarizing participants on Operating Codes and Procedures at the LDC.
 - To continue with the "Meet and Greet the Board of Directors" Convention Presentation (open forum session)
 - o Continue to promote the OHPEP Program
 - Continue to offer "Professional Liability Insurance" for active members as a membership benefit.

3. Provide <u>outreach and advocacy</u> programs to address the needs of members around the state.

Actions that will meet the intent of this goal include:

- Develop strategies for sharing the many benefits of quality health, physical education, and physical activity programming for student achievement with superintendents, administrators and classroom teachers.
- Develop strategies and programs for the membership to serve as advocates for their profession.
- Increase advocacy skills among the VAHPERD leaders and members.

 - Continue to support our Lobbyist Becky Lanier imparting information that is new ongoing/relevant and has an impact on Health and Physical Educator's Advocacy.
 - Continue promoting the OHPEP Program (*Principals Conference "Guidance for individuals who do not have a curriculum."*)
 - Create a "Convention Justification Tool Kit" Make your case as to why it is important to be able to attend VAHPERD's State Convention.
 - Create a "Higher Education Letter" from VAHPERD to school divisions and administration about the importance of HPE and what a quality HPE educator should look like. (Include a checklist)
