 - Led a partnership consisting of representatives from the City of Tempe, City of Phoenix, City of Mesa, Army Corp. of Engineers, Arizona Department of Transportation, and Maricopa County to establish policy and funding support and secure remnant parcels for the development of Tempe Town Lake (Tempe), Tempe Habitat Restoration projects (Tempe), Tres Rios Habitat Restoration (Phoenix), and Va Shly'Ay Akimel (Mesa)
