The Aerotropolis – Learn about Phoenix Sky Harbor and Phoenix-Mesa Gateway plans for major land development

Phoenix – October 15, 2017 – The Valley's leading airports have long-range plans to develop the land nearby their operations. These billion dollar airports bring millions of travelers in and out of our Valley and major import and export operations for local businesses. New land development in the surrounding areas will offer businesses expanded opportunities with cargo and transportation operations.

For Valley Partnership's Friday Morning Breakfast on November 17th, the organization will bring together leaders from two airports to offer insights into the scale and timing of these developments. Jordan Feld, Phoenix's Deputy Aviation Director, will discuss plans for a mixed-use transportation center, noise-land redevelopment and major development in the Light Rail corridor. Phoenix Mesa Gateway Airport's (PMGA) Business Development Director Shea Joachim will offer an overview on the Skybridge Development planned for the approximately 350 acres surrounding the reliever airport. Todd Hamilton of Cutler Commercial will join the conversation in sharing his expertise in the leasing of these facilities and what attracts the tenants. Molly Carson of Ryan Companies will moderate the Q & A discussion.
