



Laboratory Analyst Award

Recognizes individuals for outstanding performance, professionalism and contributions to the water quality analysis profession. The award is open to analysts in both water and wastewater laboratories. The award is given by the Water Environment Federation.

Criteria

1. Candidate must be employed at an educational facility laboratory, industrial, commercial, or municipal laboratory which performs wastewater-related analysis, and must have direct analytical responsibilities.
2. Candidates are eligible for this award only once.
3. Qualifying criteria may include:
 - a. Membership and involvement in professional associations. Examples: Water Environment Federation Committees, American Waterworks Association, Standard Methods Joint Task Groups, MA committees and conferences and conference activities.
 - b. Outstanding efforts around water, wastewater and environmental aquatic analyses, including such items as innovative sampling techniques or solutions to a treatment, analytical, or environmental problem.
 - c. Involvement in community activities or public relations
 - d. Presentations at professional conferences, meetings, etc. relevant to water quality analysis.
 - e. Professional certifications.
 - f. Continuing education.
 - g. Contributions that have been beneficial to the nominee's facility.
 - h. Unusual initiative or performance "beyond the call of duty".
