Overview:

A \$1,000 scholarship is available each year for a PA who is a WAPA member and who has made demonstrated steps toward advancing his or her career as a physician assistant.

About the Award:

Ben Redmond Lawton, MD, FACS was an eminent physician, general & thoracic surgeon, healthcare-reformer, educator, and President of the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents from 1984 to 1986. He was always a forward-thinker regarding the delivery of medical care, and was one of the first vocal supporters of physician assistant (PA) training programs.

Application:

- Applications are due each year on August 31st.
- Submission requirements:
 - Completed form (below).
 - Personal statement: The statement should be limited to one typewritten page, and should document details of the candidate's efforts and success in advancing his/her career.
 - One letter of recommendation.
- One winner will be selected by the WAPA Foundation Board of Trustees, and will be notified by early September. The winner will be presented with his/her award at the WAPA Foundation Awards Dinner in the fall.
