

## Paul S. Robinson Leadership Award Scholarship Application

### Overview:

A \$1,000 scholarship is available each year for a PA student in his/her final year of school who demonstrates exemplary leadership in their community, to the profession, to their PA program or on campus.

### About the Award:



Paul Robinson, who served two terms as President of the Wisconsin Academy of Physician Assistants from 1996-98, died unexpectedly of cardiac arrest in 2008. This award is meant to honor his legacy and commitment to leadership development.

Paul was an active member of the AAPA for nearly 20 years. He was speaker of the House of Delegates in 2005 and had also served as first vice-speaker for three terms. He served on AAPA's Professional Practice Council and its Reference, Nominating, and Public Education Committees. Paul's leadership and service were important to the success of WAPA and the PA profession in Wisconsin, as well as in the AAPA.

For his exemplary leadership, Paul was honored as the recipient of the Wisconsin Academy's PA of the Year Award in 2000.

### Application:

- Applications are due each year on August 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Submission requirements:
  - Completed form (below).
  - Personal statement: The statement should be limited to one typewritten page, and should document details of all leadership activities and a description of the candidate's passion for leadership development.
  - One letter of recommendation from a faculty member at your PA school
- One winner will be selected by the WAPA Foundation Board of Trustees, and will be notified by early September. The winner will be presented with his/her award at the WAPA Foundation Awards Banquet in the fall.
