## Academic Awards Assembly & 8th Grade Promotion Mass

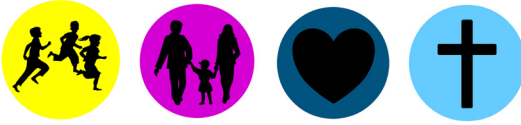

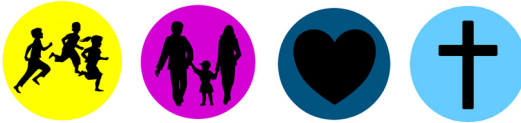
