

Scrip Terms

Scrip: A term which means “substitute money.” In our case, scrip is simply gift cards that you purchase and use for your regular, every day shopping needs instead of using cash, debit or credit cards.

Great Lakes Scrip (GLS): The organization Kennedy uses to purchase gift cards on your behalf.

ShopWithsScrip.com: 24/7 online ordering system made available to you by GLS.

Presto Pay: The most efficient way to pay for your scrip. Once you register with Presto-Pay, payment is deducted from your checking account. You may also choose to pay by check or cash.

Physical Cards: Plastic or paper gift certificates that can be used as cash.

Scrip To Go: Physical cards that we keep on hand to serve you.

Reload: Physical cards that you can purchase once, then add a dollar amount to meet your shopping needs.

ScripNow: E-gift certificates that can be used as cash or sent as gifts.

Rebate: The money you earn for yourself and Kennedy when you choose to purchase Scrip.
