A Different Team: Building Extraordinary Teams **SHRM AND CPE CREDIT AVAILABLE!**

Please join us in welcoming **Susan Alexander, PCC, Executive and Life Coach, Rosebud Coaching and Consulting, LLC**, as she discusses how trust impacts relationships within a team. Imagine that you could significantly impact the quality of the relationships among the members of your team AND the results they produce.
