

ADORAY Medical Supply

Information for Medicare Home Health Patients

Medicare regulations require that the home health agency providing your care, also provide you with certain medical supplies while you are receiving home health services.

With some exceptions, supplies that ADORAY Home Health is responsible to provide at no charge to you include.

- 1) Any supplies that Medicare has been paying for in the past that may or may not be related to your need for home health services (example: ostomy supplies).
- 2) Those supplies related to your direct care, except insulin syringes and incontinence pads. For those two items, if they are used by home health staff in the course of a visit, they will be provided. If they are used in between visits, it is your responsibility to provide them yourself.

Should you elect to obtain supplies from another supplier, and they are supplies which ADORAY is responsible to provide, you will also be responsible for payment. Drugs and personal hygiene items are generally not covered by the home health agency. If you are considering purchasing any medical supplies on your own, please check with ADORAY staff first to ensure that ADORAY is not responsible for providing the item(s).

I have read the above and understand that ADORAY Home Health, in providing the necessary treatment and care of my condition(s), will stock and deliver supplies of varying brands. ADORAY does agree to work with me and my attending physician to provide medical supplies that meet the accepted standards of medical practice for the care/treatment of my condition(s).

I will not hold ADORAY Home Health responsible for payment of any medical supplies which I continue to purchase from another supplier, even if I receive notice from the supplier or Medicare that payment was denied during the period that I was a home health patient.
