The last portion of this seminar will cover the various implied covenants in oil and gas that have been recognized at law, in Kansas and other jurisdiction, including the implied covenant to explore and develop, and the effect of the deep horizons act on that covenant, the implied covenant to market, including when a shut-in royalty may be paid to continue a lease in effect, and the implied duty to protect from offset drainage.
