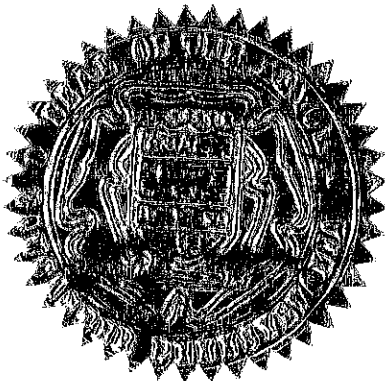


- Whereas* the City of Lancaster believes local and small businesses are the backbone of our economy and the glue that holds communities together; and
- Whereas* according to the U.S. Small Business Administration, there are currently 30.2 million small businesses in the United States representing 99.7 percent of all businesses with employees in the United States, and are responsible for 65.9 percent of net new jobs created from 2009 to 2017; and
- Whereas* these local businesses contribute positively to the community and City of Lancaster by paying taxes to help fund our municipal services; and
- Whereas* local businesses conveniently sell a wide range of great products and services; and
- Whereas* local businesses, whether they cater to neighborhoods, specialty services or other consumer needs, clearly serve a vital role in the community and City of Lancaster; and
- Whereas* supporting and shopping in these local businesses helps create jobs, reduces environmental impact, and preserve our neighborhoods; and
- Whereas* local, state and federal groups around the country have recognized the Saturday after Thanksgiving as **Small Business Saturday**, where last year consumers spent more than \$5.5 billion in local and small businesses.
