**WHEREAS**, Bullhead City, Arizona, supports our local businesses that create jobs, boost our local economy, and preserve our neighborhoods.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Tom Brady, Mayor of the City of Bullhead City, do hereby proclaim Saturday, November 24, 2018, as
